ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Method of Payment:

- Electronic Payments (ACH)
- Credit Cards (Visa & Mastercard)
- Conventional Payments (cash or check)

Payment Plans:

- 9-month: First payment due on September 1 and remaining 8 payments due by the 10th of each month
- Semester: Two equal payments due on August 20 and January 10
- Full Payment: Single payment due by August 20

Uniform Fees:

Some classes, such as PE or music, require uniforms.

Class Expenses:

Additional expenses, including such things as class trips, music tours, school pictures, or miscellaneous class supplies are not billed to account. High school Art class, Outdoor Life Skills (Wilderness), Auto-mechanics, etc., have charges as part of the class.

Textbook Fees:

Students in grades 9-12 are charged a rental fee for textbooks. The amount of the fee depends on the age and condition of the specific textbook. Up to one-half of the rental fee will be reimbursed at the end of the year if the textbook is returned in reusable condition and if the textbook will be used again the following year. Textbooks may be acquired beginning August 18. Cheaper, used textbooks will rent out first.

OPTIONAL FEE INFORMATION

Hot Lunch Program:

Livingstone Adventist Academy offers a quality vegetarian hot lunch program everyday.

Team Fees:

Extra-curricular sports programs (basketball, volleyball, soccer) and middle school gymnastics programs have fees associated with them.

Latchkey Program:

Livingstone Adventist Academy operates two latchkey programs that provide supervision for those students who need to be dropped off at school early or who cannot be picked up immediately after school. The morning latchkey program begins at 7:00 am in the cafeteria Monday through Friday and runs until 8:15. The afternoon latchkey runs from 3:15 until 5:30 pm Monday through Thursday. On Friday afternoons, latchkey runs from 2:00 until 4:30 or one hour before sundown, whichever is earlier.

Private Tutoring Sessions:

Tutoring sessions are provided as a service to our families by independent tutors. Due to state attendance requirements, sessions for high school students must be scheduled outside of class time. Payment should be made directly to the tutor.

Private Music Lessons:

Music lessons are provided as a service to our families by independent music teachers. Due to state attendance requirements, lessons for high school students must be scheduled outside of class time. Payment should be made directly to the music instructor.
